## Feeding Wild Birds

### ♣ **Little Wings Sun Country Bird Blend (J5011TP)**

- Made with a blend of milo, corn, wheat, black oil sunflower seeds and soybean oil.
- Available in 50 pound bags.
- Crude Protein 8.50 %, Crude Fat 3.5 %, Crude Fiber 22.5 %

### ♣ **Little Wings Rocky Mountain Bird Mix (J2810TP)**

- Made with a blend of white millet, chopped corn, sunflower seeds, milo, wheat, and soybean oil.
- Available in 40 pound bags.
- Crude Protein 10.5 %, Crude Fat 7.5 %, Crude Fiber 9.5 %

### ♣ **Little Wings Santa Fe Bird Seed Blend (J3000TP)**

- Made with a premium blend of millet, sunflower seeds, wheat, and safflower seeds.
- Available in 4, 25, and 40 pound bags.
- Crude Protein 10.5 %, Crude Fat 7.5 %, Crude Fiber 9.5 %

### ♣ **Little Wings Standard Wild Seed (J3000TP)**

- Made with white millet, red millet, and sunflower seeds.
- Available in 25 and 40 pound bags.
- Crude Protein 11.5 %, Crude Fat 7.0 %, Crude Fiber 11.0 %

### ♣ **Little Wings Breakfast Blend (J3000TP)**

- Made with a blend of white proso millet, safflower seed, black sunflower seed, peanuts, dried cranberries, dried raisins, dried cherries, soybean oil.
- Available in 25 and 40 pound bags.
- Crude Protein 13.5 %, Crude Fat 13.5 %, Crude Fiber 16.5 %

### ♣ **Little Wings Pigeon Mix (J2306TP)**

- Made with a blend of corn, wheat, milo, and peas.
- This combination of ingredients provides energy and protein for show and racing birds.
- Available in 25 pound bags.
- Crude Protein 11.0 %, Crude Fat 3.5 %, Crude Fiber 3.5 %

### ♣ **Little Wings Wild Bird Block (J3333LP)**

- Designed to supplement the forage found in a bird's natural environment.
- Available in 25 pound blocks.

## Wild Bird Feeding Tips


- Feed free-choice to attract a variety of birds.
- Scatter feed on the ground or fill feeders in area most traveled or inhabited by wild birds.
- To prevent waste and spoilage problems, do not distribute more feed than what the birds will eat in 1-2 days.
- Change feed regularly.
- Do not feed weather damaged or moldy feed.
- Summer feeding will keep birds in the area so that they will continue to visit feeders throughout the year.
- During the winter season, extra care should be taken to see that feeders are kept full as this may be the bird's only source of feed.

### Breeds most likely to be attracted:

- Cardinals, Doves, House Finches, Nuthatches, Woodpeckers, Towhees, Sparrows.

## Pigeon Feeding Tips

- Feed Little Wings Pigeon Mix to mature pigeons as their regular diet.
- Always provide plenty of fresh, clean water.
